Continue to pray for those in our Church that needs healing.

I feel that 2020 will be a "Challenging year", especially as the "Coronavirus"; works its way

to us, here in the United States. But I believe that this is going to be a good year, for our Church. But also continue to pray, that our Church, that we will be continually, led by the Holy Spirit and that we will, be that Church, that honors God, that follows His Word and displays our love for God and to the people, in our community, in visible and tangible ways.
